

Sunday, April 17 - Easter Sunday






Easter Breakfast Returns!

- * Donations for roof replacement fund has topped \$21,000.
- * Mortgage will be refinanced in April to cover remaining cost of roof replacement.

- * Decided to refinance to a 20-year, 5-year variable rate of 4.65%, which will lower our monthly mortgage payment to approximately \$1,250.00.
