There is much happening around All Saints Lutheran these days - God is certainly at work here among us! The season of Lent begins in March and lasts for 40 days (not counting the Sundays). In the book *Sundays and Seasons*, Lent is defined as a season of repentance, turning to God and asking for God's goodness to wipe away our sins and show us how to live anew.

Lent also turns us toward Easter and the abundant life God will offer through The Three Days (Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday).

Our Lenten services begin on Ash Wednesday, March 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7:00 pm, followed by 5 weeks of mid-week Lenten services, utilizing the *Holden Evening Prayer* as our liturgy. This worship lasts about ½ hour and includes a sermon based on the Sermon on the Mount, exploring the topics of "Blessed Are You," "Salt and Light," "Prayer and Fasting," "Do Not Worry," "Judge Not," and "Build on a Rock." I hope you'll plan on making these mid-week services a part of your Lenten journey. Come join us! We will videotape these services, like we do Sunday worship, and have it available for viewing on Wednesday evening.

If you don't feel comfortable coming to in-person worship, but would like to receive ashes on Ash Wednesday, please contact me and we'll find a time on that day for you to come to the church and receive them privately.

As I look around at our life here at All Saints, and in my own personal life, I can see the hand of God clearly guiding us. My prayer is that you sense God's presence as well and will be called into action as we all seek ways to share God's


### **Church Roof Replacement**

The following books will be available on the library cart for the month of March:


> One Incredible Moment, Celebrating the Majesty of the Manger by Max Lucado


